

MICHELLE ONG

Michelle Ong is a Hong Kong-based jewellery designer who set up the house of Carnet with her business partner Avi Nagar in 1998. Michelle started designing as a hobby in the early 1980s. Her pieces proved very successful amongst her friends, and so Ong continued to create. Now, her pieces are recognized for their intricate 'cobweb' lace-style designs. By using minimal metal, she showcases her gemstones and combines vivid colours theatrically; her fluid pavé-set stones appear to have been created with a single brushstroke. She prefers the subtle lustre of a rose-cut diamond to the dazzle of a brilliant cut, and is meticulous about craftsmanship. Her pieces take Asian influences — dragons, clouds, jade — and add a European twist, giving them international appeal.
